## N'Djamena, Chad

The Romans Project is now officially launched in Chad. On Tuesday, March 14th, Rick Calenberg met with ten denomination leaders to explain the Romans Project in N'Djamena. The hope was that they would embrace the Project and recruit pastors from their denominations to undertake and complete the requirements. Each leader committed to recruit 10 to 15 pastors to come for a conference on the following Saturday. When the day arrived, 120 pastors attended the conference. This was a very encouraging start to the Romans Project in Chad. At the end of the conference, every one of the pastors enthusiastically committed to read Romans twenty times and copy it out by hand. ## Masbate City

Philippines National Director Cesar Tallada was in Masbate City, an island province south of Manila, in early April. Thirty-two participants came to an orientation meeting held at Uma Koinonia Fellowship Center. This church is led by, a Filipino missionary from Calvary Chapel - Costa Mesa, California. The participants are leaders who can help bring the Romans Project to the whole region of 5 provinces. Masbate is one of the poorest province in the Philippines. 7 out of 10 pastors don't speak English, 3 or 4 out of 10 cannot read and write. The need to equip pastors is great here and it is a strategic region that will make it possible to extend the Project into the surrounding provinces.
