Chad: Doldiguim, Chad's new facilitator, has been encouraged by the interest RP is gaining in some region he visited during the month of October. He writes: "On 05 October, I had a meeting with some pastors of Bongor City. After I presented RP to the 8 who could attend, 6 pastors signed up to do the reading and the writing. I promised them that I will come back so that I can recruit as many pastors as I could." He returned at the end of October and writes: "The journey to Bongor was so long because the roads were very bad. I fell sick, but pastor Ken Onywoki prayed for me and I got fine." He was pleased to find out that 9 pastors had completed the initial challenge.



Zambia: On 02 November, Zinga went to Mwembeshi and met Pastor Mudekwa, a recent RP graduate (shown in the picture above). Pastor Mudekwa had organized a group of pastors, and church leaders, 18 in total, to take up the RP challenge. They had had to postpone the graduation ceremony due to lack of RP funds, but had kept in touch and had set 02 November as the new day for the graduation. Zinga writes: "I left home in the early hours of the morning. Just when I arrived at my first place to meet pastor Mudekwa who was waiting for me, before taking another 12-kilometer walk, I was told to go back because only two graduates had shown up. This is because of the heatwave (which Zambia has been experiencing this past month, October). As such a number of the people (16) agreed to move the date again to a day that will be cooler. I was a bit discouraged but encouraged myself with Romans 8:28. I have only given pastor Mudekwa two Mp3 players, then, when the team and I are ready, will either send the

Mp3 players, and request him to take photos or I will go there."

Rwanda: This past month Justin was able to follow up the PTS 2019 team of pastors. He is pleased to report that 8 pastors graduated after successfully completing the initial challenge.
