Another church member, Violet, has been reading the book of Ephesians since completing the Romans Challenge. She says, "I appreciate the convicting nature of God's Word. Ephesians is teaching me I need to be more tolerant, patient, gentle, humble and to let go quickly of those who wrong me. I am grateful for what I have learned about God through the tools RP has given me."
