But when he began to read Romans as part of the Romans Challenge, he began to discover deep truths that he hadn't known before. He is learning a lot by studying the book of Romans and these Biblical truths are influencing his own spiritual life and how he serves in his pastoral ministry.



Graduation in Botswana

Kenosi, the RP facilitator in Botswana, was able to celebrate a graduation with eleven pastors who completed the Romans Challenge. When given the opportunity to share about their experience in reading and writing the book of Romans, this is what one of the pastors shared, "I have learned that we are all sinners due to the fact that we fall short of the glory of

God. And now that we are accepted in Christ we are no longer slaves of sin... Reading the same book of the Bible 20 times helped me to read the Bible more than before. It also helped me to pray because I could see some prayer points in the book of Romans."
