



Equipping pastors to abide in and feed their congregations from God's Word.

Reaching Eastern Cameroon Achine, our facilitator in Cameroon, and Oliver, one of the regional coordinators, were able to travel to the eastern region of Cameroon to share about RP and invite pastors there to take on the Romans Challenge.

They spent two days meeting with pastors in the city of Bertoua. On the first day of their trip, they met one-on-one with some strategic pastors who are in leaders of local ministries or over multiple churches within their church's denominations. The hope is that these pastors will not only complete the challenge themselves, but will also invite others within their sphere of influence to participate in the Romans Challenge.

The following day was Sunday, Achine and Oliver split up so they could visit more churches. Between the two of them, they visited five different congregations. During their visits, they were able to present the vision of RP with pastors and church members alike. Then, in the afternoon, they met with a gathering of protestant pastors from around the city.

Throughout the two days they spent meeting with pastors, 79 pastors said they wanted to take part in the Romans Challenge. That number is continuing to grow as pastors who were recruited are now inviting other pastors to take on the Romans Challenge as well.

Before leaving, Achine appointed one of the pastors they met to be the point person for the eastern region of Cameroon. This pastor has agreed to follow up with the pastors who agreed to take on the challenge and will be encouraging them to complete the reading and writing of the book of Romans. It is exciting to have a local pastor continuing to recruit pastors even after Achine and Oliver left.
