Distributing Sermons

When pastors finish reading Romans 20 times and writing it out once by hand, they receive a device with recorded sermons on it (in the past the pastors received an MP3 player, but now they can choose between an MP3 player, SD card, or flash drive). These devices are a valuable resource, as most of these pastors do not have a clear example of exegetical preaching to draw from as they teach their congregations. The devices also include an 18 sermon series through Romans that has been translated into at least one major language for every country RP is active in.

For the past year and a half, Covid has made shipping these devices to our ministry partners across Africa incredibly challenging and in many cases impossible.

Because of the complications we faced shipping these devices to our ministry partners, a lot of pastors who completed the Romans Challenge in the past year have not received their devices yet. This has been discouraging for many of the pastors as they had looked

forward to receiving this resource.

We are so thankful that as many countries are beginning to loosen regulations we have been able to begin shipping devices out to the facilitators! Thank you to all who helped package the devices up earlier this month.

Please join us in praying that the devices will arrive without complication and that they will be a blessing to the pastors who receive them.

Reaching Togo and Mali
