Report from Zambia

Zinga, Zambia's facilitator, recently received a neat testimony in January from an RP graduate named Joseph. He writes: "Yesterday, a classmate pastor named Joseph (RP graduate) testified to me on how he and his family have been utilizing the RP mp3 player to enrich their souls. Pastor Joseph says, 'I bought big headphones, and I was consistently wearing them (as I listened to the mp3 player). This made my children begin to ask what the gadget was all about. I made each one listen

to it and it took almost the whole Friday afternoon. One of them suggested that in my church planting mission, I should involve the RP challenge Abanda, as he calls it. This mp3 player is loaded with powerful material to enrich the soul, which is clearly explained."

Pastor Joseph has recruited more pastors to take up the RP challenge. He also has not stopped reading books of the Bible repeatedly ever since he got his mp3 player. He wants to read and copy out the books of the Bible and give his handwritten transcripts as a gift to his children. He was delaying the repeated reading of the Psalms, but now has even begun that endeavor. His testimony greatly encouraged Zinga,
