Update from Guinea

Since Guinea opened to the Romans Project nine months ago, Pierre' Gnouma Leno reported in July that 273 pastors and deacons have completed the reading and writing of the book of Romans. Each of these commissioned alumni has been challenged to tell other pastors about the Romans Project. Just imagine the multiplication potential if they all follow through! One pastor in Kissidougou had this to say at his commissioning, "I was touched by this way of studying the Bible. It is very effective for our understanding and discovering many things hidden in the Bible, and it changes our way of seeing the word of God. I would ask the organizers to continue, and that all the servants of God be equipped in Guinea with this training. That is my prayer!"

Pierre' himself had this to say about the Romans Project and the value of the challenge for the equipping of pastors for the work of ministry, "The most suitable and simple means for a consistent and perfect servant before God is in the meditation on the word of God. If, therefore, we want to be servants after the heart of God, it is to dedicate ourselves to reading and transcribing like this way of the RP. If I could make a choice today, it is to only be attached to this ministry of the Romans Project. Because I'm very happy when I do!"

During the month of July, more than twenty five Romans Project Invitation and Commissioning Gatherings were held worldwide.
