Nigeria Report

National Facilitator Haruna Katura reported that 689 pastors and church leaders were recruited to the RP Initial Challenge in February. While the mission of the Romans Project is to "equip pastors to abide in and feed their congregations from God's Word," we certainly encourage church leaders – and everyone really – to take up the Romans Project Challenge. Haruna reported that a woman who was doing the Challenge inspired her pastor to complete the Challenge, and her own children grew accustomed to seeing her copying out God's word. A Sunday School teacher who completed the RP Challenge asked his children to do the same.

Kenya Report

National Facilitator Charles Naibei reported that he continued to see new recruits in February, and he

commissioned 44 pastors at a gathering in Kakamega. More pastors are on track to finish the Challenge and be commissioned in the coming months. One of the recently commissioned pastors in Kimilili shared in his testimony that he has decided to preach and have Bible studies from the book of Romans. Charles himself had this to say about his own life transformation from abiding in the word of God: "I have learned to grow in listening from God so much so that I can have a word for God's people in every place I go. My personal life is changing/ growing time by time and knowing much more about God."

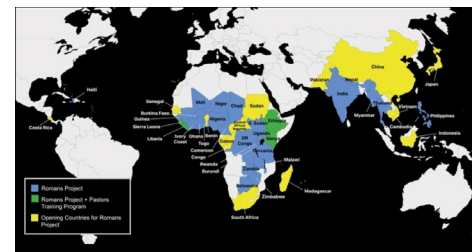


Praise God for the lives being changed as a result of the Romans Project, and for raising up and equipping godly leaders who abide in His Word.
