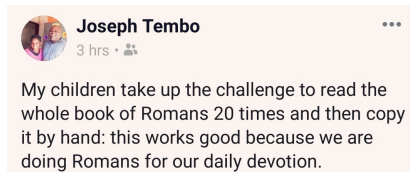

Children imitate what they observe; how encouraging that during this time of uncertainty and fear they are observing and imitating Scriptural rootedness!

In Uganda, Allan has called this the "RP Easter 2020 challenge," and has presented it to over 100 church leaders throughout the country via phone communication, as well as delegating to four others to contact church leaders in other regions.

When following up, he learned that in fewer than three weeks, one of the church leaders, James, has already read the book of Romans ten times, and Wilberforce, had already finished reading Romans five times.

Jallah has also had much success as he has worked to further RP in Liberia. This month alone he has reached two new counties and has been excited to share with us a prospective opportunity to present the challenge on the radio!
