Pray for these newly energized facilitators to remain zealous in their efforts to bring the RP to the pastors in their regions.

Update from Ethiopia

You may recall that last November, two Facilitator Gatherings were held in Africa - one in Nairobi Kenya and the other in Accra Ghana. It was at the Nairobi gathering that Eremias Bekele, the Ethiopia National Facilitator, shared that he had a goal of introducing the Romans Project to 1,000 pastors and church leaders in 2023. Eremias reported just this week that he has not only achieved this goal, he has exceeded it, with 500 having completed the challenge and awaiting their commissioning! Eremias went on to say that he will press on in 2024 as "God gives us new areas and doors for the RP." He said the RP "is a blessing for many pastors and church leaders to be a friend of their Bible."
